Power Cup 2010

The Euro Speer Cup 2010 and the Power Cup 2010 take place as part of race training by Speer Racing.

The rules for the Euro Speer Cup and the Speer Racing Power Cup have been reformulated on the basis of the rules and experiences from past years. The Speer Racing Power Cup and the Euro Speer Cup are now held according to uniform rules.

By registering for the annual ranking, you can enjoy the following benefits:

1 Ranking Classes

- Class classifications relate to the engine capacity specifications as set out in the FIM rules for the Superbike / Supersport / Superstock classes.
- A special **V2 ranking** is included in the respective engine capacity classes and is not announced separately.

No separate registration is necessary for the GP1 and GP2 classes. Each driver registered for one of the cups is automatically registered for the GP Class at no additional cost. Drivers who race on different motorcycles may start in multiple classes without additional registration fees.

2. Ranking Races

The Power Cup and Euro Speer Cup are held in six ranking races. The following dates are scheduled for the 2010 season:

3 Registration

- The registration fee is 290.00 EUR
- The booked ranking races are subject to the regular participation fee. This fee is reduced by 100.00 EUR for registered drivers.
- Any additional services required (transponder, insurance) are to be paid separately!
- Registration for end-of-year ranking must be made using the official form (see below).

4 Motorcycle and Technical Regulations

- The choice of motorcycle is free but only 4-stroke engines are permitted.
- Technical modifications are permitted unless dangerous or expressly prohibited.
- **Open motoGP and IDM Superbike exhaust systems are not permitted!**
- The choice of tyres is free; profile tyres as well as slicks may be used. Rain tyres are also permitted.

5 Race Ranking

Only registered drivers are eligible to receive points; points are scored by placement among the registered drivers as follows:

Points	25	20	16	13	11	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

In each racing class and each ranking run, trophies are awarded to 50% of the starters, up to a maximum of 10th place. Trophies are awarded in accordance with the actual placement in the race!

6 End-of-Year Ranking

- **Minimum number of participants:** a class will only be considered for end-of-year ranking if five or more drivers are registered before the final race.
- For the end-of-year ranking of all announced classes only those drivers who previously registered for the respective class shall take part.



- All drivers registered for the V2 special ranking are included in their class ranking and also in the end-of-year "V2 Special Ranking".
- The best race results of each driver will be added together. **New for 2010:** there will be no void result!
- The end-of-year ranking awards trophies up to place 5 in each class; in addition the following prizes will be awarded in each class:
