Corona crisis - joint declaration

Dear Racer,

we - the undersigned organizers - hope that you and your family are doing well according to the circumstances!

We are all intensively occupied with the dynamics of the development of the events surrounding the spread of the virus, the consequences of which will not pass us by without consequences.

Nevertheless, we are not giving up in this difficult situation and remain optimistic about the period of the restrictions now imposed on us. We know that, as motorcyclists, we operate in an environment that has always been characterised by solidarity and a sense of community.

That will be the key factor in the coming weeks. If we do not stand together now, we will not be able to pursue our hobby for a very long time. Because: The race tracks, you as participants and we as organizers are all in the same boat. Only if all three parties stay in the boat, it will be afloat again after overcoming the situation.

Therefore we ask you to leave the participation fee as a credit with your organizer in case of cancellation of an event or to transfer it to a future event. This gives us the possibility to remain capable of acting. We as organizer will not reclaim or credit the down payments that have already been paid to the race tracks and thus enable the race tracks to survive. So no party loses too much, you keep the money and the organizers and the tracks have the air to survive. We thank you already now for your understanding!

The events that are planned for the time after the end of the currently introduced travel and event restrictions are currently considered feasible.

So you can be sure that we will assess the situation on site with the greatest possible care before we hold an event with you. This concerns both the availability of the necessary medical staff and the implementation of the recommended hygiene measures on site. We guarantee that no doctor accompanying our hobby will be missing elsewhere in the fight against Corona! On the other hand, we will continue to implement the safety standards at the tracks 100%.

We are very aware of our responsibility towards you. Your safety on and off the track as well as a safe arrival and departure is our top priority.

We hope that the situation will improve soon and firmly believe that we will overcome the crisis together and meet again soon at the race track. We wish you all the best, stay strong and connected to the race track!
